### **Pros of Telemedicine**

### More convenient, accessible care for patients

Telemedicine was originally developed in the U.S. as a way to address care shortages, especially in remote rural areas. Now telemedicine is used around the world, whether it's to provide basic healthcare in third-world countries or allow an elderly patient with mobility issues to see the doctor from home. Telemedicine has the power not only to break down typical geographical barriers to care access, but to make the entire healthcare delivery model more convenient to patients.

Whether they're using a more extensive remote patient monitoring system to watch the patient's heart, or doing a videochat to answer medication questions after a hospital discharge – telemedicine leads to better care outcomes.
